Academic Policy	Faculty Rights & Responsibilities	100-??	EFFECTIVE

II. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to state the rights and responsibilities of faculty members at Adams State College.

III. DEFINITIONS:

- A. Department Chair (DC): The ASC faculty member who acts as the administrative head of an academic program.
- B. Disruptive Conduct: Behaviors or actions that prevent teaching or conducting of a class in the intended manner or that prevent students from effectively learning.
- C. Course Requirements: Assignments, projects, etc. and learning outcomes associated with and expected of all students in a class.
- D. Faculty Member: The individual responsible for course instruction in an academic discipline.
- E. Grading Criteria: The stated expectations for performance in a class.
- F. Student: Any person who is enrolled in a class, whether for credit or no credit, or who has been approved to audit a class.

IV. PROCEDURES:

- A. Procedures for faculty rights and responsibilities are stated in the policy (Section I, above).

V. RESPONSIBILITY:

- A. Each faculty member is responsible for abiding by the policies stated above.
- B. Each student is responsible for respecting faculty members' rights and responsibilities and acting in a manner that recognizes these rights and responsibilities. If they fail to do so, students are responsible for accepting any consequences that result.
