Music 592 Instrumental Conducting Seminar 1 Graduate Credit Hour

Purpose: Music 592 is a course designed for the professional instrumental music director. Requirements for course completion include: rehearsal observation, attendance at all director meetings, participation in all seminars, workshops, and discussions with clinicians, and attendance at all concerts. A short paper is also required

Registration: If you wish to register for Adams State College credit you simply need to fill out a form when you arrive here on campus, and pay your tuition fee. *If you wish to participate in the sessions, you may do so for no fee and no credit.*

Cost: In-State cost: \$181.40
Out-of-State cost: \$532.40

Items to bring: Notebook and any topics you'd like to discuss.

Final Project: A short paper is also required, based on observations of rehearsals and performances. Paper is due via e-mail by March 5th, 2007.
